A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF OIL CITY REGARDING THE SECTION 504 OFFICER AND GRIEVANCE PROCEDURE

WHEREAS, the City of Oil City recognizes that Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 provides that no qualified person with a disability shall, solely on the basis of disability, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance; and

WHEREAS, a qualified individual with disabilities is defined as anyone who meets all eligibility requirements of the program or activity; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oil City does hereby pass the following resolution.

BE IT RESOLVED, that it is the policy of the City of Oil City to avoid discriminating against individuals with disabilities in access to, participation in, equal treatment of, or employment in any of its programs or activities; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Oil City hereby appoints Kelly Amos Ryen, Director of Community Development, as the local Section 504 Officer to ensure compliance with the City's Section 504 Plan adopted by City Council on October 26, 2017; and




